



POLICY OVERVIEW

Arbor Division Ltd respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This privacy policy sets out how Arbor Division Ltd uses and protects any information you give when you use this website and how you can update and delete your information.

This Privacy Policy provides information on the collection, use and disclosure of your information that we collect when you use our website www.arbordivision.co.uk (the “Service”). By accessing or using the Service, you are consenting to the collection, use and disclosure of your information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you do not consent to the same, please do not access or use the Service.

We may modify this Privacy Policy at any time without any prior notice to you and will post the revised Privacy Policy on the Service. The revised Policy will be effective 180 days from when the revised Policy is posted in the Service and your continued access or use of the Service after such time will constitute your acceptance of the revised Privacy Policy. We therefore recommend that you periodically review this page.

HOW WE COLLECT INFORMATION

We collect and receive information from you in the following manner:

- When you fill a Contact form or otherwise submit your personal information.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We will collect and process the following personal information about you when you provide it to us through a contact form on the Service:

- Name
- Email
- Mobile number
- Address
- Details you provide so we can answer your query and/or to fulfil our contract with you.

HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

We may use the information that we collect about you for the following purposes:

- To contact you. Arbor Division Ltd will contact you by email, phone, SMS, or another form of electronic communication in response to your query submitted to us via the contact form on the Service.
- For the performance of a contract. Your Personal Data will assist with the development, undertaking, and compliance of a purchase contract for products or services you have requested through our Service.
- To manage customer orders. Your email address, phone number, social media profiles, and other user account information may be used in order to manage orders placed through our Service to comply with and process our contractual obligations.
- To enable invoicing and remittances.

HOW WE SHARE YOUR INFORMATION

We will not transfer your personal information to any third party without seeking your consent, except in limited circumstances as described below:

- Ad service
- Analytics

We require such third party's to use the personal information we transfer to them only for the purpose for which it was transferred and not to retain it for longer than is required for fulfilling the said purpose. We may also disclose your personal information for the following: (1) to comply with applicable law, regulation, court order or other legal process; (2) to enforce your agreements with us, including this Privacy Policy; or (3) to respond to claims that your use of the Service violates any third-party rights. If the Service or our company is merged or acquired with another company, your information will be one of the assets that is transferred to the new owner.

RETENTION OF YOUR INFORMATION

We will retain your personal information with us for 90 days to 2 years after user accounts remain idle or for as long as we need it to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected as detailed in this Privacy Policy. We may need to retain certain information for longer periods such as record-keeping / reporting in accordance with applicable law or for other legitimate reasons like enforcement of legal rights, fraud prevention, etc. Residual anonymous information and aggregate information, neither of which identifies you (directly or indirectly), may be stored indefinitely.

YOUR RIGHTS

Depending on the law that applies, you may have a right to access and rectify or erase your personal data or receive a copy of your personal data, restrict or object to the active processing of your data, ask us to share (port) your personal information to another entity, withdraw any consent you provided to us to process your data, a right to lodge a complaint with a statutory authority and such other rights as may be relevant under applicable laws.
